New Business

ASCLS Legislative Day - John Wentz

this year's emphasis was to limit the damage to laboratories of the Medicare Modification recently considered by Congress.

in exchange for dropping the 20% laboratory co-pay, a demonstration project on competitive bidding for laboratory services was included in the bill.

note: the demonstration project hasn't been funded yet.

- 87 ASCLS members spoke to representatives of members of congress; special emphasis was placed on trying to assure that laboratory people would have a seat on the advisory committee for the demonstration project.
- the bill for funding allied health education is deferred until the next congress; most current federally funded allied health grants require interdisciplinary activities which is difficult or inappropriate for most medical laboratory educational programs.

the Medical Laboratory Shortage Act is still in committee at Congress.

- still requesting an update to the specimen collection fee; reimbursement (\$3.00) is still based on 1984 prices.
- John Wentz has been appointed the Region VII representative to the ASCLS Government Affairs Committee.

Remarks from Barbara Brown, ASCLS President
